Free screenings also available to eligible women over 64 without Medicare Part B.

Must meet income guidelines.

Free transportation is available in most areas. Ask about free transportation when you make your appointment.

Free treatment may be available to clients diagnosed with cancer through a Show Me Healthy Women provider. Treatment is not available to non-US citizens.

Free heart health risk screenings and education services are available through many Show Me Healthy Women providers.
