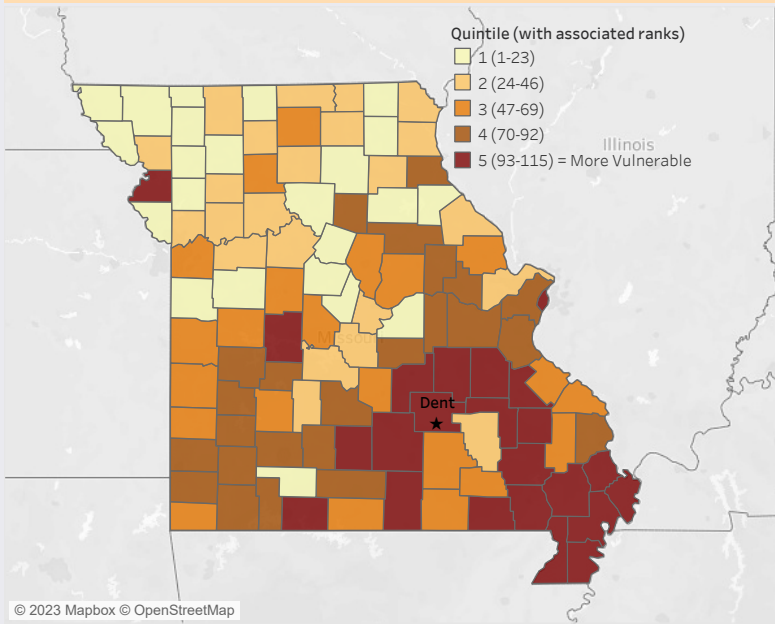
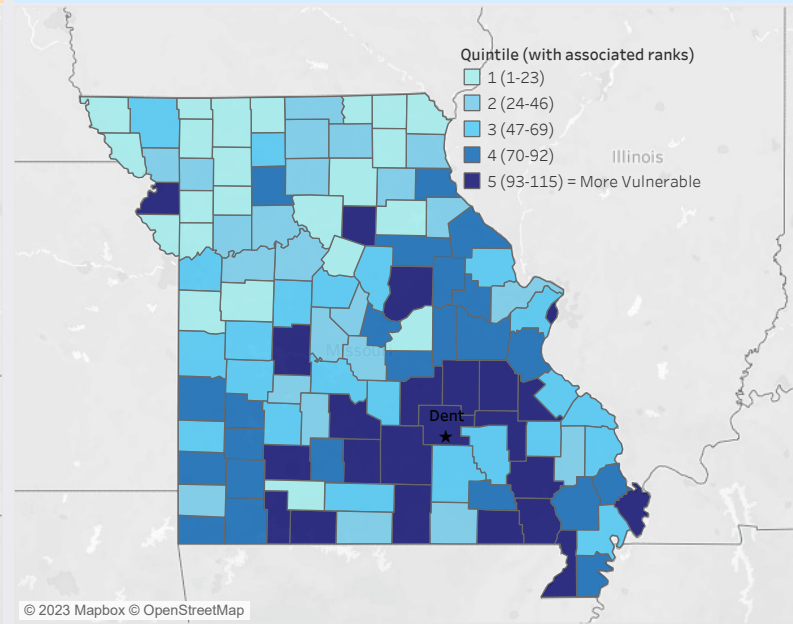


# 2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Dent County

## Opioid Overdose



## Bloodborne Infection



Dent County ranked in the 5th quintile (113th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (108th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In both the opioid overdose and the bloodborne infection assessments, Dent County's worst ranking was for the rate of drug OD deaths by county of record at 114th. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the county's rate of poverty and rate of uninsured had the lowest rankings.
