Know Me Through My Eyes: Enriching End-of-Life Dementia Care

Life in the later stage of dementia should include times filled with recognition and celebration of one's personhood. Professional care partners often feel at a loss while trying to create meaningful connections with elders where communication is difficult, resulting in a void of emotional connection, enjoyment and comfort for the person at the most vulnerable time of her life.
