In a move to close the gap between residents and employees, Leslie introduced her employees to a contest called “Through the Looking Glass.” The contest is open to all employees and the participants are required to stay at the nursing home as residents. They sleep in the same rooms, eat the same foods, and endure simulated physical and mental challenges similar to what nursing home residents endure.
