## **Provisional Vital Statistics for March 2022**

**Live Births** decreased in March as 5,703 Missouri babies were born compared with 5,842 born one year earlier. For the cumulative 3-month period ending with March, births also decreased. However, for the 12 months ending with March, births increased from 68,509 to 69,148.

**Deaths** increased in March as 5,796 Missourians died compared with 5,643 in March 2021. Deaths also increased for the 3-month period ending with March, but decreased slightly for the 12-month period ending with March. For January-March, deaths increased from 18,697 Missouri resident deaths to 20,385, or 9 percent.

The Natural Increase in March for Missourians was actually a decrease of 93 (5,703 births minus 5,796 deaths). There was also a natural decrease for both the 3- and 12-month periods ending with March. For the 12 months ending with March, the natural decrease was 6,321 compared to a decrease of 7,242 in 2021.

**Marriages** decreased in March, and for January-March. However, for the 12 months ending with March, marriages increased by 5.4 percent from 33,889 to 35,722.

**Dissolutions of Marriage** decreased in March and January-March, but increased for the 12 months ending with March. For the 12 months ending with March, the marriage to divorce ratio decreased from 2.04 to 2.02.

**Infant Deaths** decreased in March as 40 Missouri infants died compared with 43 in March of 2021. For the 12 months ending with March, the infant death rate decreased from 5.9 to 5.7 per 1,000 live births.

This will result in a delay in reporting, but will more accurately reflect current trends.
