The purpose of this amendment is to approve the redirection of funds in the amount of \$240,030 from contractual category to salaries and wages, \$3,500 from other costs to the supplies category and \$18,750 from equipment to the contractual category, as requested in grantee correspondence dated 07/14/2015.
