AWARD INFORMATION

Incorporation: In addition to the federal laws, regulations, policies, and CDC General Terms and Conditions for Non-research awards at <u>https://www.cdc.gov/grants/federal-regulations-policies/index.html</u>, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) hereby incorporates Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) number CDC-RFA-DP19-1908, entitled Preventing Maternal Deaths: Supporting Maternal Mortality Review Committees, and application dated May 1, 2023, as may be amended, which are hereby made a part of this Non-research award, hereinafter referred to as the Notice of Award (NoA).
