PROJECT TITLE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGES Missouri 2016 Lead Licensing and Accreditation Program This program is to assist the State of Missouri with the implementation of a comprehensive lead-based paint program to reduce the risk of childhood lead poisoning. The program includes, training and certifying lead-based paint professionals, outreach to the public, and monitoring and enforcement to identify, correct, and deter non-compliance with lead-based paint abatement regulations and requirements. This decrease amendment lifts the payment (drawdown) restriction on 1% of the Federal share of the award and withdraws \$2,202 to comply with the requirement for the rescission of funds appropriated to EPA in the State and Tribal Grants account under Public Law 113-235. This decrease amendment also makes conforming changes to the recipient's budget and cost share, as appropriate. In addition, this amendment rebudgets funds in order to complete approved workplan activities.
