
MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SENIOR SERVICES NEWBORN HEARING SCREENING PROGRAM MOHear MAP



The MOHear Project is a collaboration between the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services' (DHSS) Newborn Hearing Screening Program (MNHSP) and Missouri State University (MSU). The project is supported by a federal grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). The MNHSP contracts with MSU to: (1) provide unbiased information to families of newborns diagnosed with severe to profound permanent hearing loss and (2) link newborns to services by regionally-focused efforts at reducing loss to documentation and follow-up at each step of the early hearing detection and intervention process.
