METABOLIC FORMULA PROGRAM

The Metabolic Formula Program provides financial assistance to Missouri residents who meet the financial and medical eligibility criteria of the program. If you are not financially eligible for the program, service coordination is available to help you find providers of service for your condition.

Eligibility:

Medical eligibility for the Metabolic Formula Program is documented with a written medical diagnosis of one of the following conditions: phenylketonuria (PKU); maple syrup urine disease (MSUD); glutaric acidemia; homocystinuria; methylmalonic acidemia; citrullinemia; argininosuccinic acidemia; isovaleric acidemia; 3-hydroxy-3-methylglutaryl CoA lyase deficiency (HMG); 3-methylcrotonly CoA carboxylase deficiency (3MCC), propionic acidemia, long-chain 3 hydroxyacyl CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (LCHAD), very-long-chain acyl-CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (VLCAD), ornithine transcarbamylase deficiency (OTC) and tyrosinemia (type I, II and III).

All third party payors must be utilized before the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) will consider reimbursement. DHSS is the payor of last resort. Applicants and program participants must apply for MO HealthNet (Medicaid) benefits or medical assistance and complete the application process to obtain or maintain program eligibility. Program Services:

- DHSS will provide financial assistance to program participants for the purchase of metabolic formula. Prescriptions for formula must be filled at a DHSS contracted provider.
