<p>By June 30, 2020, PATNC, will increase the percentage of completed AAP recommended well-child visits from 85% to 90% as determined from submitted age forms.</p>	<p>Thirty percent of the families enrolled in the program are homeless mothers. We would like to continue serving these high needs families and work on strengthening their connections with their child's primary care providers to ensure all well checks are being administered.</p>	<p>Continue bi-weekly visits with families and include discussions of health care requirements at all visits. Ensure parent educators are aware of scheduled doctor's visits. Instruct parent educators to provide a PAT well child handout to parents at scheduled home visits.</p>

Include well child checks in weekly monitoring tool that is distributed to parent educators.</p>	<p>Due to the current pandemic, completing well child visits has been a challenge.
