Throughout the cycle, the Lead will keep an eye on completed age forms in REDCAP and the Program Assistant will be in charge of the monthly medical reminders that go out the families.	The medical reminder in place as well as the successful completion of the age forms from families will help ensure completion of targeted goal. The REDCAP well child visit report reflected that out of the 98 completed age forms, 70 reflected that the well child visits were completed. Our current percentage is 71%, 4 % difference from our targeted goal.	DAEOC EHS HBO will continue to encourage and inform parents of the importance of well child visits and their children's development through education and providing resources. We will continue to give parents medical reminders to ensure that they are aware and have adequate time to plan and schedule their child's well child visits. Although we did not make our targeted 22% increase, our completion rate did rise so the methods that we have in place do support improvement.
