- Advises the director of the Department of Health and Senior Services on all matters that affect health equity for all Minority populations.



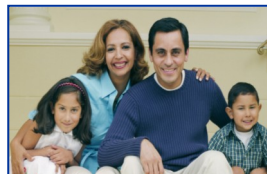
The Office of Minority Health is responsible for:

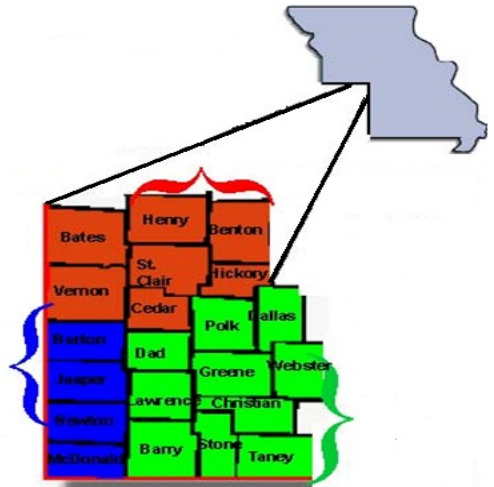
