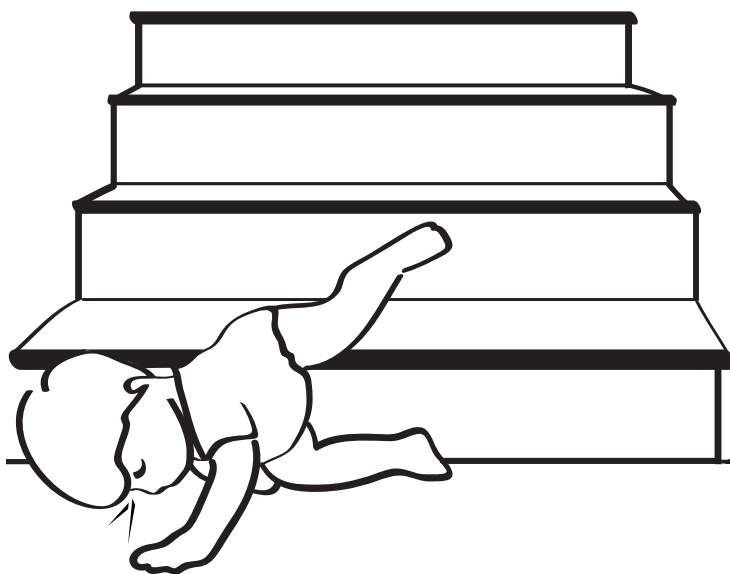


Some Causes
