Vomiting
Sick to stomach
Decreased strength
Decreased coordination or poor balance
Decreased sucking/swallowing
Decreased ability to lift or hold head
Decreased smiling/vocalizing
Decreased language/communication
Decreased tolerance to light
Decreased appetite
Frequent rubbing of eyes
Decreased ability to focus eyes
Extreme irritability/Increased crying
Unequal pupil size of eyes
Swelling of the Soft Spot
Sleep changes
Appears dazed or confused
Acts as if head hurts (headache)
Lost consciousness
