## WIC PARTICIPANT FRAUD MAY INCLUDE:

- Buying or selling WIC checks, foods or formula or allowing someone else to do so.
- Posting WIC checks, foods or formula for sale in newspapers or on the internet (through websites such as Craigslist, Facebook, eBay, etc.).
- Giving away WIC checks, food or formula.
- Altering WIC checks in any way.

The Missouri WIC program takes all complaints seriously and encourages the immediate reporting of any alleged WIC program abuses, violations or fraud.

If you suspect a WIC participant or a store authorized to accept WIC has committed fraud, please report it to your local WIC provider or the WIC state agency.
