


332Z – Short Interpregnancy Interval



Starting October 3, 2016 this system change will occur.

Since RF 332 - Short Interpregnancy Interval is changing from conception before 16 months postpartum (any pregnancy – live birth, neonatal loss, etc.) to conception less than 18 months for a live birth, there were changes made to how the data is collected in MOWINS.

Any women who met the old criteria [\leq 16 months] will have RF 332Z assigned to them to maintain historical data.



Since there will be some instances where RF 332 was assigned to a woman who had a neonatal loss, stillbirth, etc., certifying staff will need to **assess** any RF 332Z assignments.

If the pregnancy resulted in a live birth, RF 332 will need to be assigned by checking the 'Live Birth within 18 Months' check box on the Health Information screen of the woman.
