

## **Emergency Room Visits for Diabetes**

Missouri, 2006

In Missouri, there were 9,852 Emergency Rooms (ER) visits for diabetes as the principal diagnosis in 2006; the rate of visits was 1.6 per one thousand population (age-adjusted using 2000 Standard Population). The rate was higher in older Missourians and African-Americans, but the same for male and female. The 3-year moving average rate of ER visits for diabetes increased from 1.0 in 1995 to 1.6 per thousand in 2006. The 10-year average rate for visits was higher in southeastern Missouri than the other regions. Clark County had the lowest rate, 0.1 per thousand; Reynolds County had the highest, 3.2 per thousand.
