

#### Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWDs)

- 18-49 year olds with no disability
- SNAP limited to 3 months within 36 months if don't meet work/ education requirements
  - Work= 80 hours/month
  - Education/Training= 80 hours/month
