#### **PURPOSE**

To increase awareness impact of injury and violence on children, provide strategies to advocate for children and build resiliency through injury, abuse and violence prevention. This bi-state initiative, designed for and by child safety advocates, focuses on the latest information related to unintentional and intentional childhood and adolescent injuries.

- Engage in discussion to promote safe sports participation.
- Identify the current initiatives for addressing the challenges of transporting children safely.
- Create change by actively engaging in injury prevention advocacy and education.
