Protect yourself and your loved ones from vaccine-preventable diseases.

Each year on average in the U.S., about 50,000 adults die from vaccine-preventable diseases or their complications.

Vaccine-preventable diseases cause long-term illness, hospitalization and even death.

Talk to your health care professional or medical provider about these vaccines:

- ✓ Flu
- ✓ HPV through 26 years of age
- ✓ Tdap
- ✓ Hepatitis A
- ✓ Hepatitis B
- ✓ Shingles at 60 years of age or older
- ✓ Pneumococcal at 65 years of age or older

If you are uninsured or your insurance does not cover vaccines you may qualify for low cost vaccines. Contact your local public health agency for details.
