
# Vaccines For Your 6 6 N

# Dear Parent/Guardian:

Missouri state law requires all students be immunized against vaccine-preventable diseases.

You must provide proof of your child's immunizations prior to 8th grade or 12th grade entry. Call your child's medical provider to verify your child's immunizations are up-to-date.

### **REQUIRED IMMUNIZATION**

Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) (1 dose)

**Meningococcal (MenACWY)** (meningitis) (8th grade - 1 dose, 12th grade - 2 doses, unless first dose was administered on or after 16 years of age)

### **OTHER RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATIONS**

Varicella (chicken pox) (2 doses)

Influenza (flu) (1 dose annually)

## Human Papillomavirus (HPV)

**Meningococcal B (MenB)** (2 or 3 doses, depending on vaccine brand)

Children may be eligible to receive free vaccines through the Vaccines for Children program before their 19th birthday.
