

#### (This policy supersedes all previous policies issued on this subject.)

317 funding is temporarily available for Shingrix vaccine. Hepatitis A vaccine can temporarily be administered to any uninsured or underinsured adult. CDC is also offering 317 funded influenza vaccine for **all** adults regardless of insurance status during the 2020-2021 influenza season. All vaccine is subject to availability. Please remember 317 vaccine funding is provided by CDC and is <u>limited</u>.

## 1. Please note the terms "uninsured" or "underinsured" do <u>not</u> include:

- □ Individuals with health insurance that covers immunizations;
- □ Individuals with Medicare (unless the vaccine is not covered); or
- □ Individuals with Medicaid coverage for vaccine.

# 2. Providers are to utilize the following 317 funded vaccines <u>for adults who meet the</u> <u>following criteria</u>:

#### Zoster (Shingrix)

□ Uninsured and underinsured adults. Vaccine must be ordered by September 25, 2020 and administered by June 30, 2021.

## Hepatitis A

- Uninsured and underinsured adults. Utilize current inventory or order by September 25, 2020.
- Outbreak control <u>and prevention</u> activities subject to approval of DHSS:
  - People experiencing homelessness;
  - People who use drugs (injection or non-injection);
  - Men who have sex with men (MSM);
  - People who are, or were recently, incarcerated;
  - People with chronic liver disease, including cirrhosis, hepatitis B, or hepatitis C; or
- □ People with close contact to any of the populations above. Post-exposure prophylaxis:
  - Uninsured or underinsured Resettlement Program refugees needing immunizations as part of their domestic health exam;


\* Note: pediatric hepatitis A 317 funded vaccine may be used for outbreak response and prevention if approved by DHSS. Administer VFC vaccine to VFC-eligible patients, use 317 funded vaccine for non-VFC-eligible patients.

#### Influenza

All adults may be vaccinated during the 2020-2021 influenza season with 317 funded vaccine.

## Tdap

- Uninsured or underinsured:
  - Parents/guardians and/or caregivers who have contact with infants 12 months of age or younger;
  - Wound management for adults who are Underinsured or uninsured.
  - Resettlement Program refugees needing immunizations as part of their domestic health exam;



Section 317 Funded Vaccine for the Adult Population

(19 years and older)\*

September 1, 2020

- Outbreak control activities subject to approval of DHSS; or
- Disaster response efforts approved by DHSS.

# Td

- Underinsured or uninsured:
- Disaster response efforts approved by DHSS.

## Hepatitis B and Twinrix

Missouri

- □ Uninsured or underinsured adult:
  - Sex partners of Hepatitis B surface antigen (HBsAg)-positive persons;
  - Persons with more than one sex partner during the previous six months;
  - Persons seeking evaluation or treatment for a sexually transmitted disease;
  - Men who have sex with men;
  - Current or recent injection-drug users;
  - Household contacts of HBsAg-positive persons;
  - Health-care and public safety workers with reasonably anticipated risk for blood or blood-contaminated body fluids;
  - Persons with end-stage renal disease;
  - Persons with chronic liver disease;
  - Persons with HIV infection; or
  - Resettlement Program refugees needing immunizations as part of their domestic health exam.

# MMR

- Outbreak control activities subject to approval of DHSS; or
- Underinsured and uninsured adults:
  - Entering medical/nursing school;
  - Health care personnel; or
  - Resettlement Program refugees needing immunizations as part of their domestic health exam.

# Meningococcal ACWY& B

- Outbreak control activities subject to approval of DHSS; or
- □ Underinsured or uninsured:
  - Students for enrollment criteria; or
  - Uninsured or underinsured Resettlement Program refugees needing immunizations as part of their domestic health exam.

## Pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (PNEUMOVAX 23)

□ Underinsured or uninsured individuals recommended by ACIP to be vaccinated.

## Varicella

- □ Outbreak control efforts subject to approval of DHSS;
- Underinsured or uninsured:
  - Students for enrollment criteria; or
  - Uninsured or underinsured Resettlement Program refugees needing immunizations as part of their domestic health exam.
