Each year, MDHSS-CFNA will provide information media (television, radio, or newspaper) serving the area from which the institution draws its attendance with a public release. All public releases shall announce that child care homes that participate in the Child and Adult Care Food Program provide nutritious meals and staff oversight with access to nutrition-related training, technical assistance and monitoring from the Department of Health and Senior Services, without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability.
