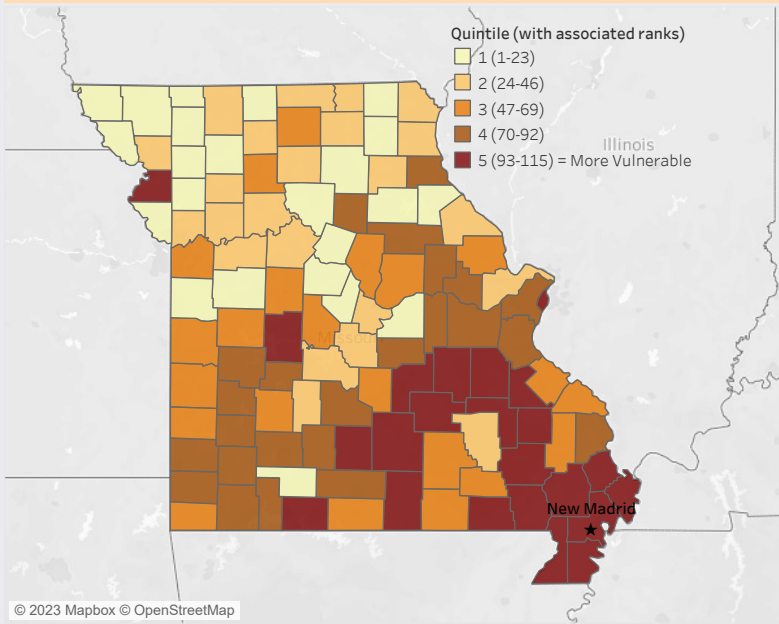
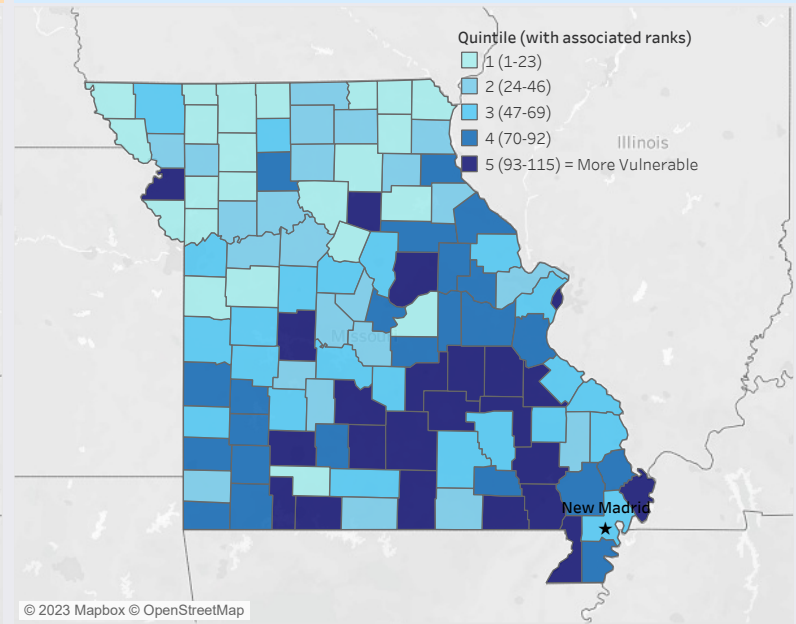


2022 Vulnerability Assessment: New Madrid County

Opioid Overdose



Bloodborne Infection



New Madrid County ranked in the 5th quintile (100th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 3rd quintile (67th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In the opioid overdose assessment, New Madrid County's worst ranking was for the rate of poor mental health days. For the bloodborne infection assessment, none of the indicators placed in the 5th quintile, but the indicator that ranked the worst was the rate of drug OD deaths by county of residence. Social and economic factors were included in both of these assessments and had a major impact on the county's rankings with all 5 factors placing in the 5th quintile. The worst ranked factor was the percent of the county's population without a high school education at 107th.
