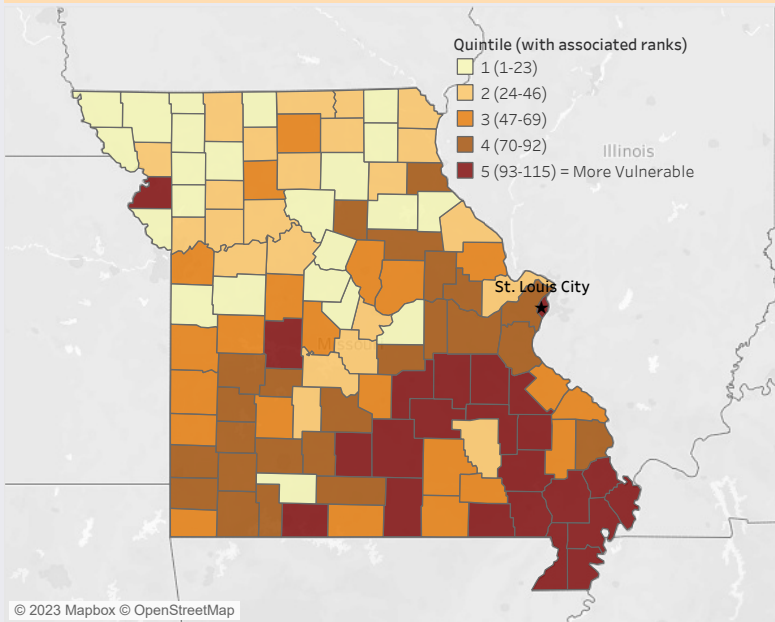
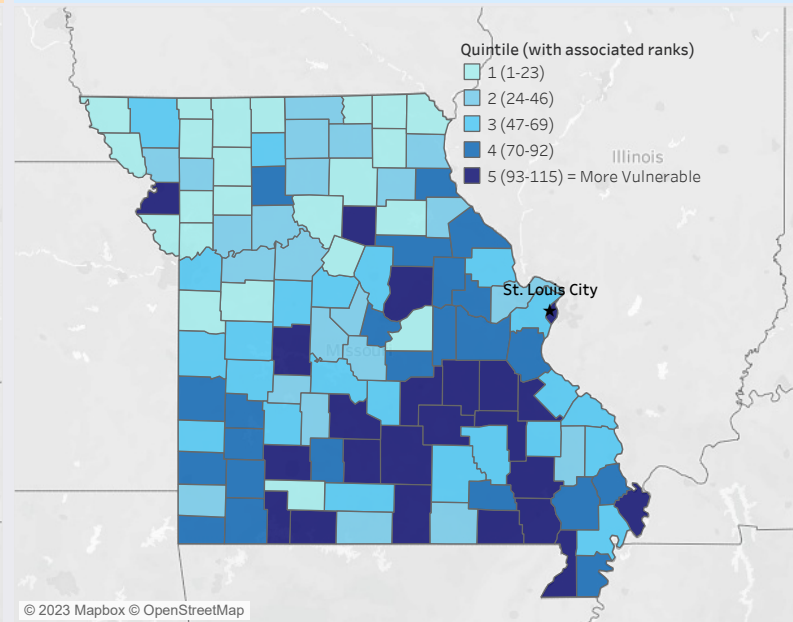


2022 Vulnerability Assessment: St. Louis City

Opioid Overdose



Bloodborne Infection



St. Louis City ranked in the 5th quintile (110th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and was in the 5th quintile (112th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment as well. In the opioid overdose assessment, St. Louis City placed in the 5th quintile for 9 out of 11 indicators and was ranked the worst out of all counties in 6 of those indicators. For the bloodborne infection assessment, St. Louis City placed in the 5th quintile for 12 of the 14 indicators and was ranked the worst of all counties in 5 of those indicators. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the city's rate of unemployment was its lowest rank at 104.
