VA REQUIREMENTS - THE 3Ms

- ★ **MILITARY Service:** Minimum 90 days active duty, with at least one day during wartime, and honorable discharge;
- ★ **MEDICAL Need:** Non service-connected disability which requires assistance with activities of daily living;
- ★ **MONEY (Financial Limitations):** Limited resources in relation to medical expenses.
