

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR  
ADULT BRAIN INJURY PROGRAM SERVICE COORDINATORS  
SECURE WEBSITE**

1. Go to <http://www.health.mo.gov/>
2. Scroll to bottom of page and in the middle under “Useful Links” choose **Site A-Z**.
3. Choose either **Adult Brain Injury Program** under “A” or under “H” choose **Head Injury Program**. Or you can choose “S” then look for Special Health Care Needs and the **Adult Brain Injury Program** will be under it.
4. Once you are on the Adult Brain Injury page, scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on the **three asterisks**. You should see a User Name/Password box asking for User name and Password. Type in **TBI** after User name. Type in **LINK** after Password. Make sure TBI and LINK are in caps.
5. On the Service Coordinator Secure Website main page, click on the underlined words in color to go directly to that topic.
