PROPOSED RECISSION

19 CSR 30-20.030 Construction Standards for New Hospitals. This rule established up-to-date construction standards for hospitals both new and renovated to help ensure accessible, functional, fire-safe and sanitary conditions.

PURPOSE: The Department of Health and Senior Services is rescinding this rule and replacing it with more up-to-date construction standards for hospitals that reflect current construction practices.

AUTHORITY: sections 197.005.2 and 197.080, RSMo 1986. This rule previously filed as 13 CSR 50-20.040 and also 19 CSR 10-20.040. Original rule filed Nov. 29, 1982, effective March 11, 1983. Amended: filed May 31, 1989, effective August 24, 1989.*

**Original authority: 192.005.2, RSMo 1985 and 197.080, RSMo 1953.*

PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) annually.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
