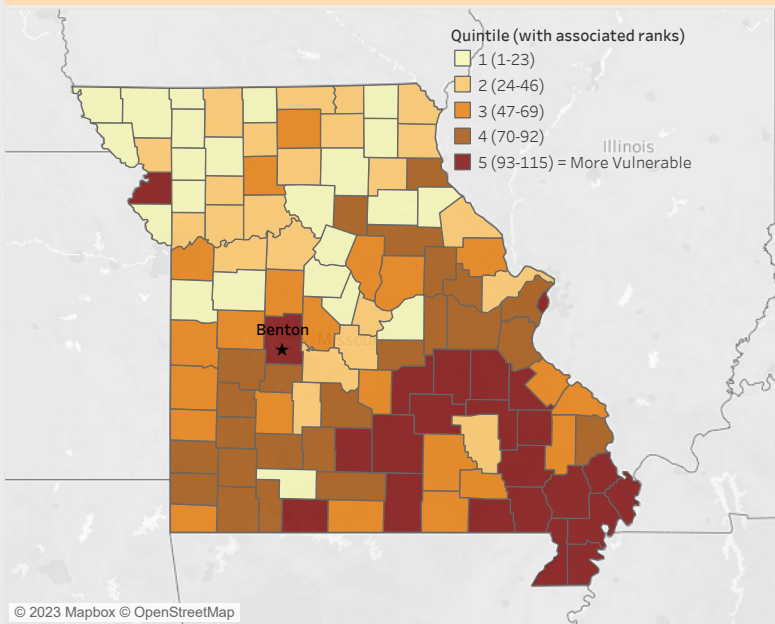
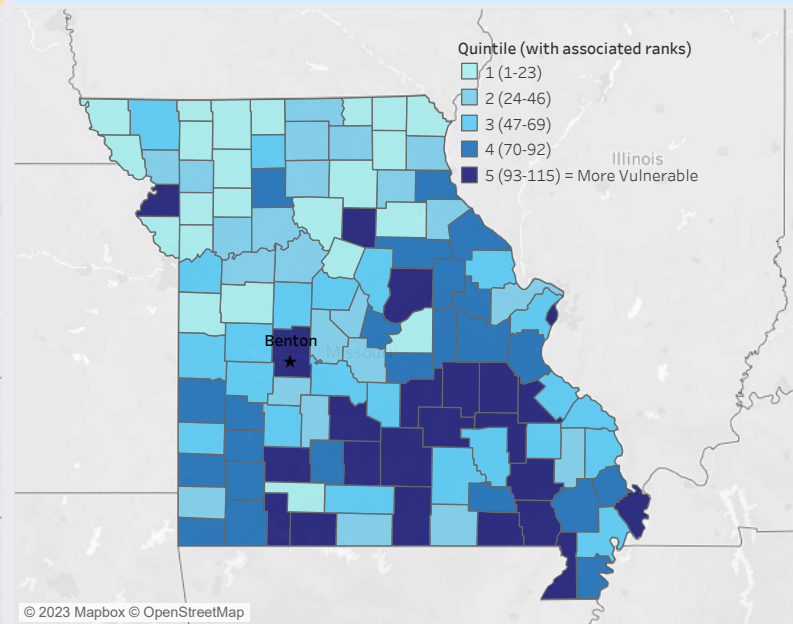


# 2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Benton County

## Opioid Overdose



## Bloodborne Infection



Benton County ranked in the 5th quintile (96th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (93rd) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment as well. In the opioid overdose assessment, Benton County did not place in the 5th quintile for any individual opioid indicator, but because of its consistent placement in the 4th quintile combined with several indicators in the 4th and 5th quintile in the community factors, this resulted in the overall index placing it in the 5th quintile. For the bloodborne infection assessment, the county's worst ranking was for the rate of Injection Drug Use (IDU) among Substance Use Disorder Treatment (SUDT) recipients which ranked at 95th. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the county's unemployment rate, at a ranking of 112th, was its lowest ranking.
