
2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Madison County



Madison County ranked in the 5th quintile (93rd out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 3rd quintile (67th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In the opioid overdose assessment, Madison County's worst ranking was for the rate of drug OD deaths by county of residence. This factor was also the county's worst ranking for the bloodborne infection assessment. While social and economic factors were included in both of the assessments, they did not have an indicator place in the 5th quintile; the worst ranking for the community factors was the percent of the county's population without a high school education.
