
2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Mississippi County



Mississippi County ranked in the 5th quintile (112th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (112th) for the bloodborne vulnerability assessment as well. In the opioid overdose assessment, Mississippi County's worst ranking was for the rate of opioid-related Substance Use Disorder Treatment (SUDT). For the bloodborne assessment, it was for the rate of Injection Drug Use (IDU) among Substance Use Disorder Treatment (SUDT) recipients. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments and had a major impact on Mississippi County's ranking with all 5 of the community factors placing in the 5th quintile. The percent of the county's population without a high school education ranked 115th, placing it last out of all of Missouri's counties for this factor.
