
2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Stoddard County



Stoddard County ranked in the 5th quintile (98th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 4th quintile (82nd) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In both the opioid overdose assessment and the bloodborne infection assessment, Stoddard County's worst ranking was for the rate of drug-related arrests. Even though Stoddard County only had one indicator place in the 5th quintile for both assessments, many other indicators placed high in the 4th quintile for the opioid overdose assessment raising its overall placement into the 5th quintile. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the percent of the county's population without a high school education was its lowest rank.
