
2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Stone County



Stone County ranked in the 4th quintile (87th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (98th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In the opioid overdose assessment, Stone County's worst ranking was for the rate of opioid misuse ER visits at 100th. For the bloodborne infection assessment, its worst ranking was also for the rate of opioid misuse ER visits, but an additional indicator, the rate of HCV among ages 18 to 40, also placed in the 5th quintile. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the county's unemployment rate was its worst ranking at 95th.
