
2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Wayne County



Wayne County ranked in the 5th quintile (109th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and was in the 5th quintile (106th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment as well. In the opioid overdose assessment, Wayne county ranked in the 5th quintile for 3 out of 11 indicators with the worst ranking indicator being the rate of drug-related arrests at 113th. For the bloodborne infection assessment, Wayne County was ranked in the 5th quintile for the rate of HCV among ages 18 to 40 and for the rate of drug-related arrests. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and Wayne county ranked in the 5th quintile for all 5 of the community factors.
