As with opioid overdose deaths, ER visits with opioid misuse diagnoses show high rates for many counties surrounding the St. Louis area. Also of note is a secondary clustering of counties with high rates in west and southwest Missouri, though less concentrated around the Springfield metro area than the death data. Note that because these statistics are based on the residence of the patient, they can be impacted by access-to-care issues.
