Redbud Village CON Request for Extension

Regarding question 1:

Capital expenditures are not anticipated for another year. Once the largest sponsorship cohort can be developed then capital expenditures associated with construction will begin.

Regarding question 2.

The reason that this (and probably 1 to 2 more) extension(s) will be required is that the owners are actively engaged in expanding the sponsorship base of their organization. The Mennonite church has a unique tithing apparatus that calls for each member (as an example, a family of 5 would constitute 5 members) of a sponsoring church agrees to contribute, to the nursing home, the sum of \$7.50 per member per month for LIFE. So, the more churches (each church may contain 300 to 600 members) that sign on as project sponsors, the more permanent income gets generated for the project. They currently have 13 churches with over 3900 members and are actively engaged in securing additional Mennonite churches into their sponsorship group.

Regarding question 7:

Preliminary financing has been secured and a commitment to build the entire project via multiple bank financing has been obtained. The Mennonite community is not accustomed to doing things via credit but rather is prone to saving and paying cash. This project is so big that they are availing themselves to the requirement for credit but wish to minimize its use. They have excellent credit due to their bias toward large amounts of equity and a firm commitment to repaying debt early when they do take out loans. They have the ability to finance Redbud Village via bank financing now but, as is their practice, they wish to build the equity via their tithing model which will reduce the amount of eventual permanent financing.
