Examples of disallowed expenses included but not limited to the following:

- 1. HIV testing or the purchase of HIV tests
- 2. Purchase of vehicle without approval
- 3. Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) or Post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) medications
- 4. Medications (medications for clients will be provided through another contractor)
- 5. Syringe exchange program-related expenses
- 6. Services for incarcerated persons, except transitional case management, per PCN #18-02. https://hab.hrsa.gov/sites/default/files/hab/program-grants-management/PCN-18-02-people-who-are-incarcerated.pdf
- 7. Non-client-specific or non-service-specific advocacy activities
- 8. Costs associated with operating clinical trials
- 9. Inpatient services or medical services

- 11. Direct cash payment to clients

- 21. Moving costs
- 22. Purchase of land or construction

- 25. Funeral/burial expenses
- 26. International travel
