

Examples of disallowed expenses included but not limited to the following:

1. HIV testing or the purchase of HIV tests
2. Purchase of vehicle without approval
3. Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) or Post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) medications
4. Medications (medications for clients will be provided through another contractor)
5. Syringe exchange program-related expenses
6. Services for incarcerated persons, except transitional case management, per PCN #18-02.

7. Non-client-specific or non-service-specific advocacy activities
8. Costs associated with operating clinical trials
9. Inpatient services or medical services

11. Direct cash payment to clients
12. Clothing
13. Advertising
