AWARD INFORMATION

Incorporation: In addition to the federal laws, regulations, policies, and CDC General Terms and Conditions for Non-research awards at https://www.cdc.gov/grants/federal-regulations-policies/index.html, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) hereby incorporates Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) number CDC-RFA-CE22-2201, entitled Advancing Surveillance of Violent Deaths Using the National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS), and application dated April 3, 2024, as may be amended, which are hereby made a part of this Non-research award, hereinafter referred to as the Notice of Award (NoA).

Total Approved Funding is included in Summary Federal Award Financial Information on page 1 of the NOA. All future year funding will be based on satisfactory programmatic progress and the availability of funds.

The federal award amount is subject to adjustment based on total allowable costs incurred and/or the value of any third-party in-kind contribution when applicable.

Financial Assistance Mechanism: Cooperative Agreement

Substantial Involvement by CDC: This is a cooperative agreement and CDC will have substantial programmatic involvement after the award is made. Substantial involvement is in addition to all post-award monitoring, technical assistance, and performance reviews undertaken in the normal course of stewardship of federal funds.

CDC program staff will assist, coordinate, or participate in carrying out effort under the award, and recipients agree to the responsibilities therein, as detailed in the NOFO.

CDC will provide technical assistance to recipients through a variety of mechanisms described below.

- Provide case definitions as well as documentation and descriptions of how to collect required data elements.
- Provide a web-based system to enter data, export data to the recipients, and share data with CDC. The web-based data entry system will also support data quality by providing data summaries and implementing data entry rules, including restricting data entry to valid values.
- Provide training on how to use the web-based data entry system.
- Provide recipient results from CDC monitoring and evaluation activities including updates on key performance measures, CDC Data Quality Reports, CDC case reviews, and observations from CDC site and reverse site visits when resources are available.
- Work with recipients to solve challenges identified in evaluation and monitoring activities such as problems of missing or inaccurate data.

 Maintain a help desk for abstraction questions and questions about the web-based data entry system.

Expanded Authority: The recipient is permitted the following expanded authority in the administration of the award.

 Carryover of unobligated balances from one budget period to a subsequent budget period. Unobligated funds may be used for purposes within the scope of the project as originally approved. Recipients will report use, or intended use, of unobligated funds in Section 12 "Remarks" of the annual Federal Financial Report. If the GMO determines that some or all of the unobligated funds are not necessary to complete the project, the GMO may restrict the recipient's authority to automatically carry over unobligated balances in the future, use the balance to reduce or offset CDC funding for a subsequent budget period, or use a combination of these actions

FUNDING RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

- Generally, recipients may not use funds to purchase furniture or equipment. Any such proposed spending must be clearly identified in the budget.
- Reimbursement of pre-award costs generally is not allowed, unless the CDC provides written approval to the recipient.
- Other than for normal and recognized executive-legislative relationships, no funds may be used for:
 - Publicity or propaganda purposes, for the preparation, distribution, or use of any material designed to support or defeat the enactment of legislation before any legislative body
 - The salary or expenses of any grant or contract recipient, or agent acting for such recipient, related to any activity designed to influence the enactment of legislation, appropriations, regulation, administrative action, or Executive order proposed or pending before any legislative body

- The direct and primary recipient in a cooperative agreement program must perform a substantial role in carrying out project outcomes and not merely serve as a conduit for an award to another party or provider who is ineligible.

Indirect Costs: Indirect costs are approved based on the negotiated indirect cost rate agreement dated March 3, 2023, which calculates indirect costs as follows, a Provisional is approved at a rate of 20.80 percent of the base, which includes, direct salaries and wages including all fringe benefits. The effective dates of this indirect cost rate are from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2026.
