AWARD INFORMATION

PURPOSE: No-Cost Extension is approved for CDC-RFA-PS18-1802, Integrated HIV Surveillance and Prevention Programs for Health Departments. This amendment is to extend the current Budget period and Period of Performance, an additional two-months. The budget and period of performance end dates have been extended from <u>06/01/2024</u> to <u>07/31/2024</u>.

PROGRAMMATIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Recipients will be required to submit a <u>two-month budget</u> (June 1 July 31, 2024) and workplan due 30 days after the issuance of the Notice of Award.
- If the recipient needs additional funds, after the Notice of Award is issued, a recipient may submit a recipient initiated supplemental amendment via GrantSolutions.

EXPANDED AUTHORITY: The recipient is permitted the following expanded authority in the administration of the award.

☑ Carryover of unobligated balances from one budget period to a subsequent budget period. <u>Unobligated funds may be used for purposes within the scope of the project as originally approved</u>. <u>Recipients will report use, or intended use, of unobligated funds in Section 12 "Remarks" of the annual Federal Financial Report</u>. If the GMO determines that some or all of the <u>unobligated funds are not necessary to complete the project</u>, the GMO may restrict the recipient's authority to automatically carry over unobligated balances.

STEWARDSHIP: The recipient must exercise proper stewardship over Federal funds by ensuring that all costs charged to your cooperative agreement are allowable, allocable, and reasonable and that they address the highest priority needs as they relate to this program.

All the other terms and conditions issued with the original award remain in effect throughout the budget period unless otherwise changed, in writing, by the Grants Management Officer.

CLOSEOUT REQUIREMENTS

Recipients <u>must submit all closeout reports</u> identified in this section within 90 days of the period of performance end date, <u>October 29, 2024</u>. The reporting timeframe is the full period of performance. If the recipient does not submit all reports in accordance with this

section and the terms and conditions of the Federal Award, CDC may proceed to close out with the information available within one year of the period of performance end date unless otherwise directed by authorizing statutes. Failure to submit timely and accurate final reports may affect future funding to the organization or awards under the direction of the same Project Director/Principal Investigator (PD/PI).

Final Performance Progress and Evaluation Report (PPER): This report should include the information specified in the NOFO and is submitted via <u>www.grantsolutions.gov</u>. At a minimum, the report will include the following:

- Statement of progress made toward the achievement of originally stated aims;
- Description of results (positive or negative) considered significant; and
- List of publications resulting from the project, with plans, if any, for further publication.

All manuscripts published as a result of the work supported in part or whole by the grant must be submitted with the performance progress reports.

Final Federal Financial Report (FFR, SF-425): The FFR should only include those funds authorized and expended during the timeframe covered by the report. The Final FFR, SF-425 is required and must be submitted no later than 90 days after the period of performance end date through recipient online accounts in the Payment Management System. The final FFR will consolidate data reporting responsibilities to one entry point within PMS which will assist with the reconciliation of expenditures and disbursements to support the timely close-out of grants. The final FFR must indicate the exact balance of unobligated funds and may not reflect any unliquidated obligations. Remaining unobligated funds will be de-obligated and returned to the U.S. Treasury
