Re: Breach of Security of Personal Information

Dear [Name]:

We are sending this letter to you as part of the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services' ("Department") strong commitment to privacy. You are receiving this notice because a breach of security of some of your personal information was recently discovered.

This breach occurred because, sometime before September 30, 2016, an information technology contractor for the State of Missouri, who had worked on a Department information system, improperly retained the information. The (now former) contractor then allowed the information to be stored in an electronic file that was not password-protected. Your name in combination with a Department identification number (not your social security number) issued and used by some State agencies when providing services to citizens was included in the electronic file. When the Department learned of this situation, it took immediate steps to secure the information.

At the present time, the Department has no reason to believe that the information was actually viewed or used by anyone intending harm. Regardless, you should remain vigilant by reviewing account statements and monitoring free credit reports for unusual activity. Contact information for consumer credit reporting agencies is below. You may wish to contact these agencies to place a free fraud alert on your credit or to request a free credit freeze.
