

**Reporting Reference Ranges for TSH: (uIU/mL)**

“<” means “is less than”

“≥” means “is greater than or equal to”

24 - 95	< 25	25 - 49	≥ 50

336 - 503	< 12	12 - 49	≥ 50
≥ 504	< 12	12 - 24	≥ 25

\*Any results that are collected at less than 24 hours of age and in the high risk range are brought to the attention of the supervisor for review. If a repeat newborn screen is not received in a timely manner, a call will be made to the baby’s primary care physician indicating need for a repeat newborn screen.
