Background


A collaboration between A.T. Still University and the Office of Dental Health

The Smiles for Veterans Program at A.T. Still University's (ATSU) Missouri School of Dentistry and Oral Health (MOSDOH) partnered with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services' Office of Dental Health (ODH) to provide non-covered dental services to veterans. This program identifies veterans with critical oral health needs and provides services to help improve their oral health and overall health. These services include oral health screenings, exams and care interventions, which may include deep cleanings, extractions, root canals, crowns and dentures as identified by the clinic.

Services Provided

Types of services and associated costs


ATSU partnered with ODH for a contract period from April 17-Aug. 31, 2024. During this time, the MOSDOH clinic was able to provide 417 different types of services to 129 veterans. These services included: exams, x-rays, cleanings, fillings, crowns, scaling, periodontal work, dentures, extractions and alveoloplasties (surgical reshaping of the jawbone for dentures). The total cost of the services provided was \$56,106.15, with \$20,000 coming from the Veteran's United Foundation, and the remaining funds coming from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA).





