#### Medicaid to Now Cover Periodic Oral Exams Twice a Year!

The Office of Dental Health gave a media interview to the Beacon News focused on MO HealthNet (Medicaid) adding D0120 (Periodic Exam) to the adult Limited Dental Coverage. Without coverage for D0120 it was difficult for dental providers to provide a 'Dental Home' to adult patients. This newly covered code allows adults to be seen by a dental provider regularly and allows providers to provide preventive care. Providers have shared that D0120 not being included in the Limited Adult Benefit prevents them from seeing adult patients receiving Medicaid benefits because they cannot provide routine care, only emergency services.

Missouri was featured in the national American Dental Association news with further Medicaid wins. "Missouri saw more than 100 new providers sign up to participate in Medicaid for 2024....The fiscal year 2025 budget also included \$2.4 million towards additional coverage for dental anesthesia and extraction codes in parity with Medicare." 
