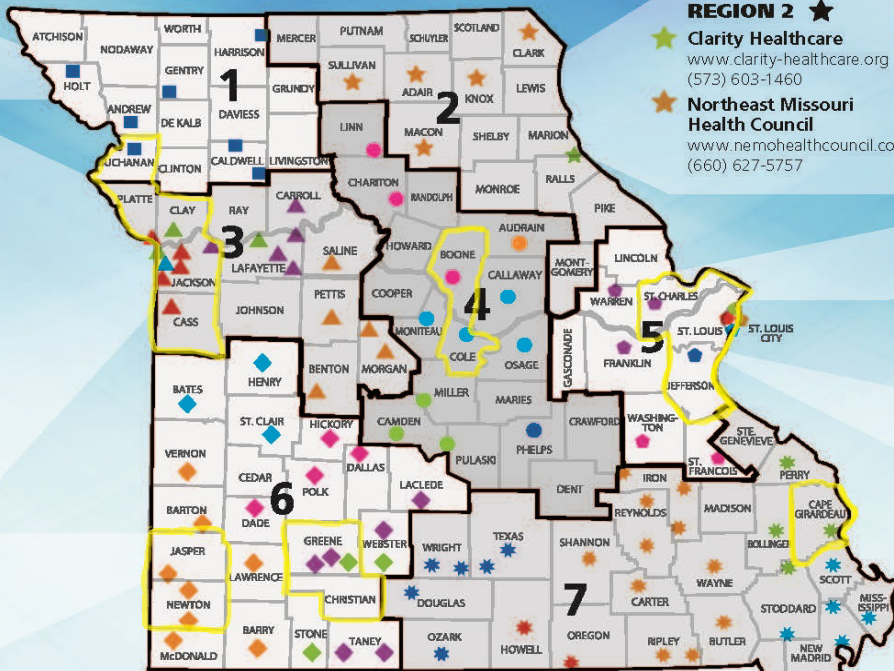

# Missouri's CHCs...

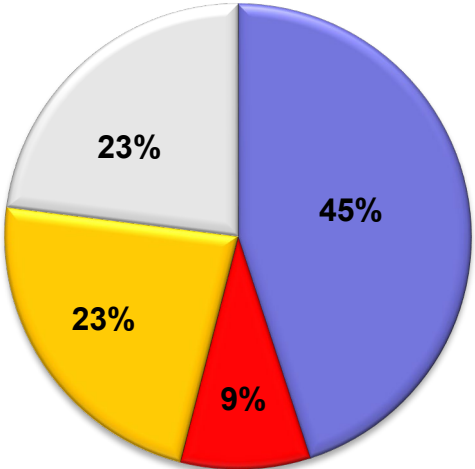
- Are located in areas where care is needed but scarce.

### MO CHC Patients By Insurance Type

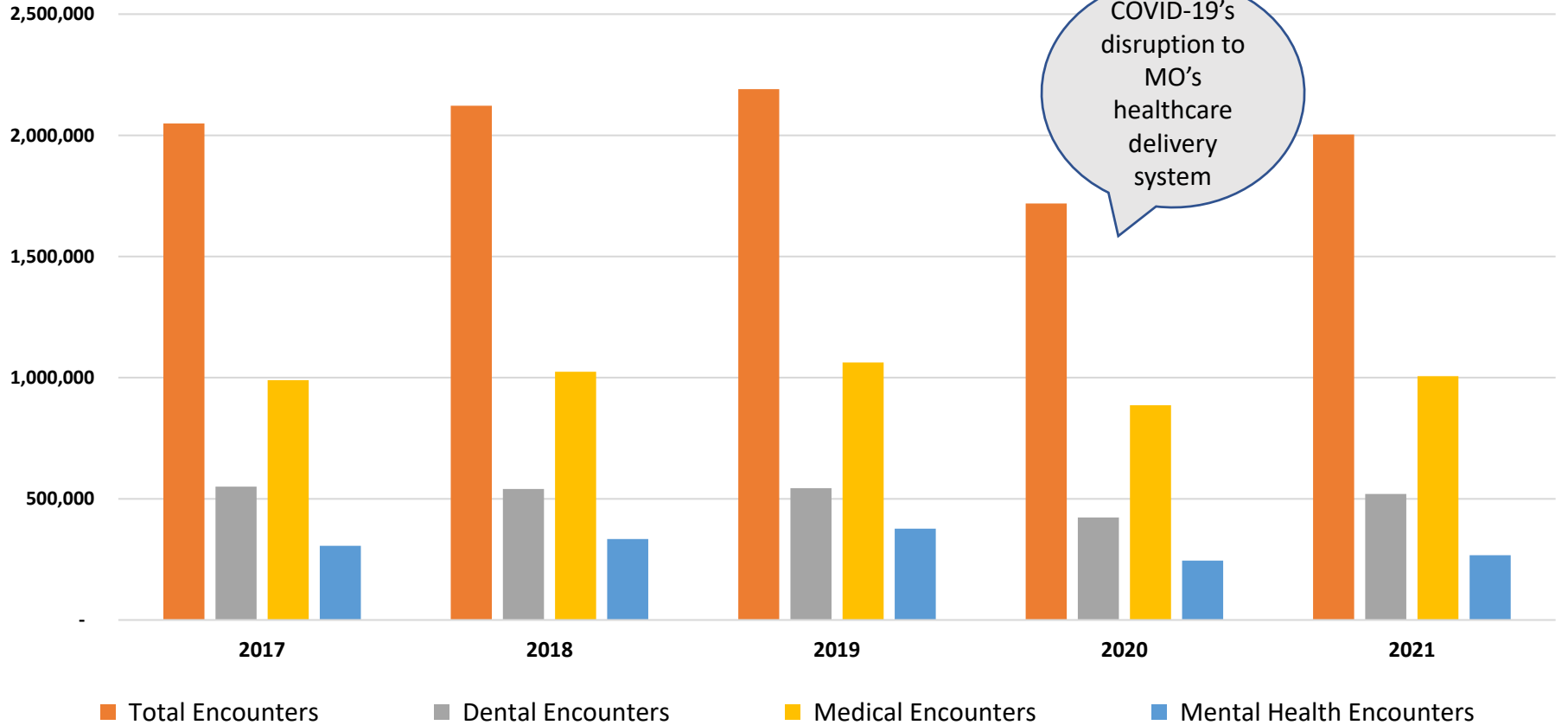


■ Medicaid ■ Medicare ■ Uninsured ■ Private Insurance



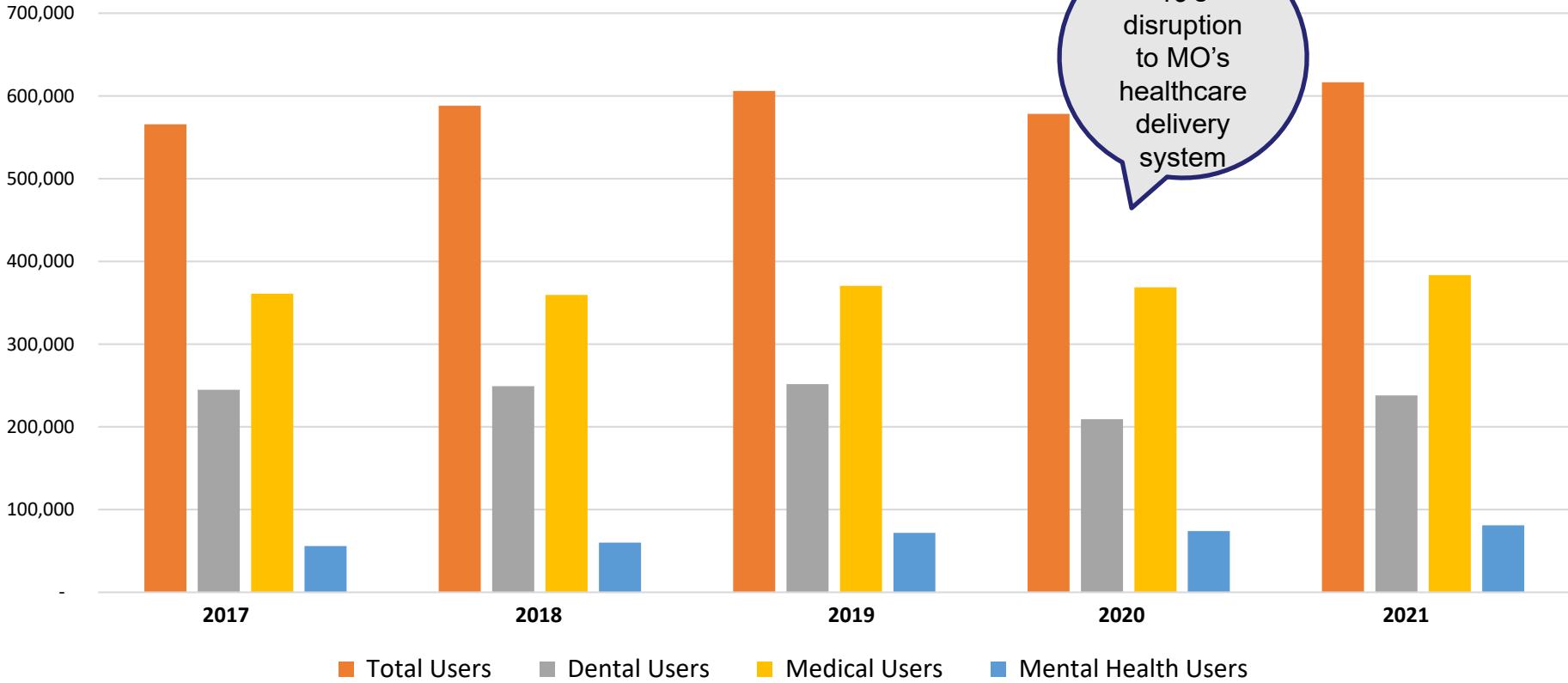
