Ryan White Case Management provides access to medical care and other services needed to help people with HIV manage their overall health.

WHO CAN GET HELP?

To be in the program, you must be HIV positive, live in Missouri and meet income eligibility requirements. If you don't meet one of these criteria, other help may be available for people with HIV.



WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

You will be connected with a case manager in your local community to talk about your needs and goals. They will provide you with information about HIV/AIDS, medical care, sexual health and more.

If you need assistance, your case manager can also help you find HIV medical care and link you to supportive services and resources in your community.

WHAT CAN I GET HELP WITH?

- ▶ Paying for medical visits and medications
- ▶ Mental health care
- ▶ Dental care
- ▶ Housing support
- ▶ Food

- ▶ Substance Use Treatment
