

WHO:

Students from Missouri universities interested in pursuing a career in public health are eligible. The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) in partnership with Missouri State University Master of Public Health Program with funding from the CDC's Infrastructure Grant.

**WHAT:** 

Students will receive a stipend of up to \$6,400 for completing an internship of up to 320 hours.

WHEN:

Matching occurs before the start of each semester:

- Fall Semester: June 1
- Summer Semester: April 1
- Spring Semester: November 1

Deadline to apply:

- Fall Semester: May 17, 2024
- Summer Semester: March 15, 2024
- Spring Semester: October 18, 2024

WHERE:

Internships will be funded for field placements in Missouri local public health agencies (LPHA) and DHSS.

WHY:

This program will strengthen the public health workforce by providing funds for students to gain experience by working in a LPHA or DHSS for up to 320 hours.
