Section 317 Funded Vaccine for the Adult Population (19 years and older)

(This policy supersedes all previous policies issued on this subject.)

All 317 vaccines are subject to availability. Remember 317 vaccine funding is provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and is limited.

All 317 vaccine orders must be submitted separately and not included with VFC Pediatric orders. In order to ensure equitable distribution of 317 vaccine, all orders will be reviewed and reduced as necessary by program staff.

Failure to comply with the policy or excessive wastage may result in a reduction or loss of ability to order 317 vaccines.

Vaccines available to order:

Hepatitis A

Hepatitis B

HPV (19 through 45 years of age)

MenACWY

Men B

MMR

PPSV23

Tdap

Twinrix

Varicella

Zoster (19+ years of age with a weakened immune system or 50+ years of age)

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Adults 19 years of age and older:
 - a. Uninsured A person who has no health insurance.
 - b. Underinsured A person who has health insurance, but the coverage does not include vaccines or a person whose insurance covers only selected vaccines.

 Underinsured does not include individuals with a deductible plan and copay.
 - c. Food service workers may receive 317 funded vaccines only if they are uninsured or underinsured.
- 2. In addition to the above, fully insured individuals may receive 317 vaccines during a public health response activity as declared by DHSS. A public health response activity includes:
 - a. Outbreak response
 - b. Post-exposure prophylaxis
 - c. Disaster relief efforts
 - d. Mass vaccination campaigns or exercises for public health preparedness
