



## WHAT IS MHAP?

MHAP is a **statewide perinatal psychiatry access program** designed to give health care providers the resources they need to confidently **identify and manage** their patients' **perinatal mental and behavioral health conditions**.

Enrolled providers have **free access** to 1:1 phone **consultations with perinatal psychiatrists**, as well as **resource and referral services, trainings**, and other **educational resources**.

## WHO CAN REGISTER?

**Any provider** in the state treating and/or interacting with patients during pregnancy or in the 12 months following delivery, including (but not limited to):

- OB/GYNs
- Midwives
- Doulas
- PCPs
- CHWs
- BHCs
- Pediatricians
- Social workers
- RNs
- Psychiatrists
- NPs
- Home Visitors
